

CLASS RULES AND REGULATIONS

AQHA SPECIFICATIONS

*Open to registered quarter horses. Riders must have their own membership card.
Please include copy of AQHA registration papers and exhibitor's current membership card.
AQHA memberships are available in the show office.*

Amateur & Youth: Exhibitor or immediate family member must be owner of the horse. Youth may not show a stallion in a Youth class.

Novice Classes: Open to riders with "Novice" denoted on membership card. May not show a stallion.

Junior Horse: Horse five years old or younger. May be shown in snaffle bit or hackamore. No more than three horses may be entered by same exhibitor.

Senior Horse: Horse six years of age and older. Must be shown in bridle. No more than three horses may be entered with same exhibitor.

REINING SPECIFICATIONS

*Approved NRHA classes will require a NRHA membership and Horse Competition License. Classes will be run according to the NRHA rulebook.
Horse Competition License and memberships available at show.*

**CLASSES CLOSE THE DAY PRIOR AT 4PM
CLASS ORDERS WILL BE POSTED THE NIGHT PRIOR BY 6PM**

Intermediate Open: Exhibitor has earned less than \$25,000 in NRHA earnings except Category 3,7 & 9 earnings.

Limited Open: Exhibitor has earned less than \$10,000 in lifetime earnings except Cat. 3,7 & 9.

Non Pro: Exhibitor holding a current NRHA Non Pro card. Non Pro cards are available at the show.

Intermediate Non Pro: Non Pro who has earned less than \$15,000 in all NRHA earnings except Category 3,7 & 9 earnings over the previous three years.

Limited Non Pro: Non Pro who has earned less than \$4500 NRHA category earnings except 3,7 & 9 over the previous three years.

Prime Time Non Pro: Non Pro 50 & Over. May enter other Non Pro classes.

Novice Horse II: Horse has not earned more than \$25000 lifetime earnings in all categories except 3,7,9.

Rookie II: Non Pro rider who has not earned in excess of \$500 in NRHA lifetime earnings and have not earned more than 50 youth points.

Rookie I: Non Pro rider who has not earned in excess of \$200 in NRHA lifetime earnings.

PCHA Jack & Linda Baker Qualifier: Open to Amateur and Youth riders. Owners, riders, and trainer must be members of PCHA. The horse must be registered with PCHA to qualify. May join at the show.

CRHA SPECIFICATIONS

Classes are under the guidelines of NRHA class specifications

Green as Grass: Open to Non Pro & Youth riders who are in the first or second consecutive year of showing reining. Riders in this class cannot have earned more than \$50 (lifetime) in any reining competition, nor can they have won a yearend award from any organization in reining. Yearend Green as Grass Champion and Reserve are no longer eligible.

Jackpot classes: Jackpot earnings go towards yearend awards.
